HISTORY.—Some 18 months ago a number of Old Etonians began to raise the funds necessary for building at Hackney Wick, East London, two Clubs, one for Boys aged 14–18, and one for those above that age who had passed through the Boys' Club with credit to themselves and benefit to the Club.

The success of the effort to arouse amongst Etonians an increased personal interest in what is being done at Hackney Wick has been very great.

The Eton Mission, which has been in existence in this district for some 30 years, has done and is doing admirable work, but the latter, being entirely parochial, is of a kind in which it is difficult for the ordinary layman to participate.

The new Clubs are to be independent of the Mission, but to insure complete harmony the Eton Council nominates three Members of a Committee which is to control these Clubs.

FINANCES.—The present financial position in round figures is as follows:—

Of this nearly £10,000 has been received or promised, leaving still to be collected £8,000.

In addition to the above, a small but very comfortable house, costing £3,000, has been erected near the new building. In this house those who manage the Clubs can live. A friend has generously presented this house to the Club, and the rent will provide a source of annual income to the Club funds.
