Objectives

To successfully prepare students for all papers of the STEP exam by:

- o introducing strategies and techniques for approaching and solving problems
- o showing how to recognise mathematical patterns and choose the best strategy
- o demonstrating how to write rigorous mathematical proofs and check concepts
- o linking concepts to develop mathematical thinking

Format

Students will be required to actively participate in seminars and to discuss and share ideas with other group members. There will be a range of talks, practical sessions and presentations, including visits to a museum and art gallery.
